

Evergreen Music Mentors

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Overview

Evergreen Music Mentors is a music tutoring business which provides services such as one on one private tutoring, group mentoring, and much more in the Evergreen Music Community. Such sessions are run by high school students, which is beneficial in that the students can gain knowledge directly from an everyday ensemble player, and relate to someone near their age. Founded in October 2018 by Evergreen Valley music students, they envision spreading our musicality and technical skills to our community. The mentors have accumulated many years of experience in music theory and instrument mastery, and are excited to be able to spread their in-depth knowledge of music to you. They, as musicians and mentors, want to spread the love of classical music to the next generation.

Goals

- 1. Mentor the younger generation of musicians from middle school
- 2. Give back to the music community, starting with the Quimby Oak Band Program

Future Intentions

- 1. Expand to elementary schools, such as Carolyn Clark, Holly Oak, and Tom Matsumoto.
- 2. Establish an introductory elementary-school strings program to raise interest in stringed instruments (similar to San Jose Academy of Music from a couple years ago, which is no longer offering this program)

Services

Private Client - The mentor hosts a private lesson with their middle-school student. The student has the freedom to choose where on Quimby Oak's campus is most comfortable for them to have their lesson. The mentor will focus mostly on solo music, technique, and sight reading with the student, and occasionally take a look at ensemble pieces.

Cadre - The mentor hosts a small group and teaches in the same way as a private lesson. Cadres are usually small groups of 2-4 people which focuses of technique and tonality of the instrument.

MasterClass - The mentor hosts an instrument sectional. Larger sections will have multiple mentors assigned to them. This is typically organized by the band director. The mentor will focus solely on the ensemble pieces and provide general feedback on technique/intonation that apply to the whole section.

Milestones

Evergreen Music Mentors would like to achieve the following milestones by the end of the year:

- 1. Have our first session with lots of students and mentors
- 2. Make the program a weekly/biweekly event
- 3. Give at least 5% to the music community
